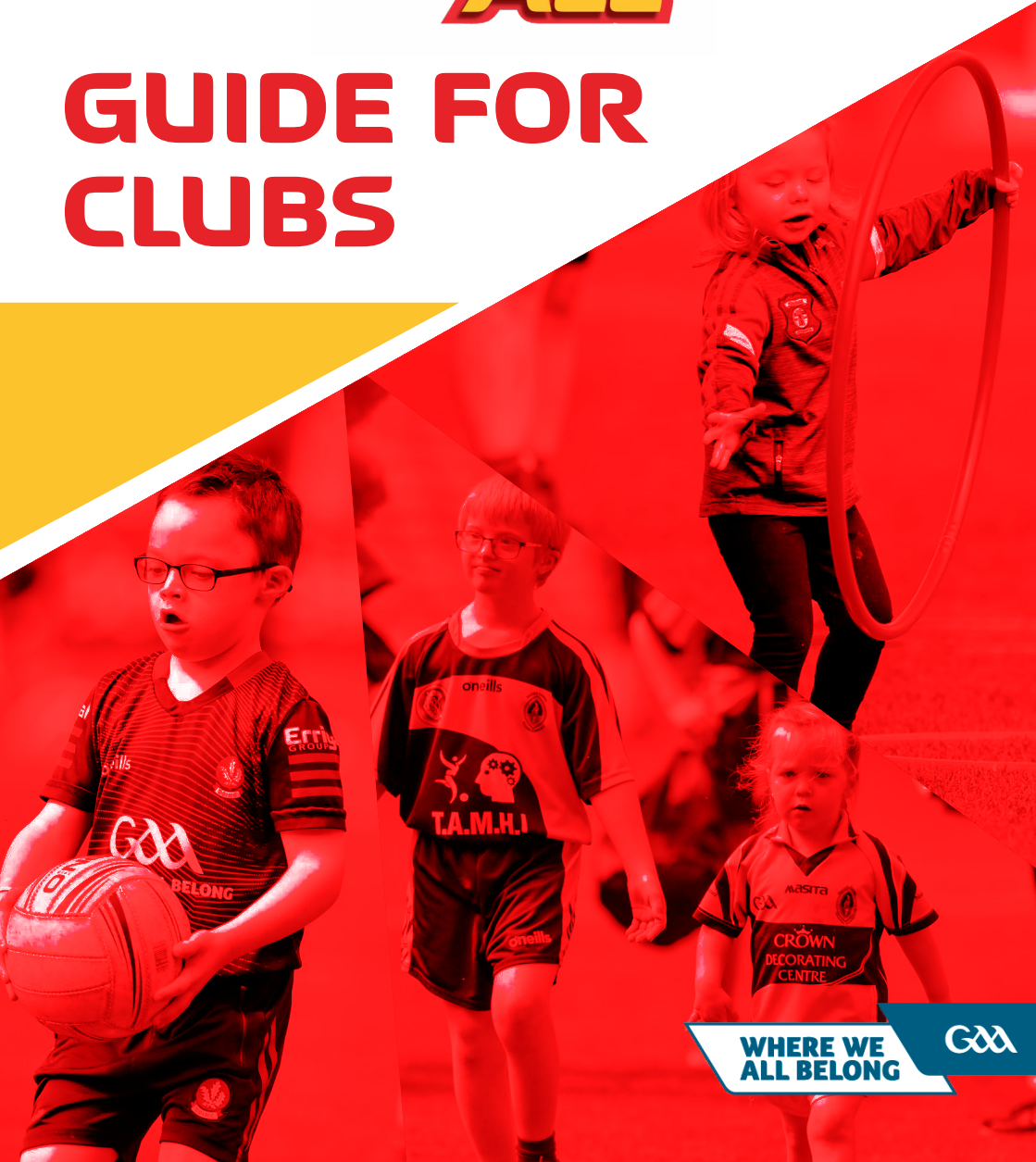

# ***What is Games for All?***

The first line of the GAA Official Guide spells out how the GAA reaches into every corner of Ireland and many communities around the globe. In doing this, the GAA is fully committed to the principles of inclusion and diversity at all levels

**Aim: To offer an inclusive, diverse and welcoming environment for everyone.**

**Inclusion means** -people having a sense of belonging, of being comfortable in being part of something they value. Inclusion is a choice.

**Diversity means** -being aware of accommodating and celebrating difference. Inclusion and Diversity in many ways go together. Real inclusion reflects diversity, i.e. it aims to offer that sense of belonging to everyone, irrespective of gender, marital status, family status, sexual orientation, religion, age, race or minority community and/or disability.

## ***Steps to get started...***

- Establish a small sub-committee within your club
- Put out a call asking for those interested in helping to get in touch
- Contact the appropriate person in your County (contact details below)
- Organise Introduction to Gaelic Games Course and/or arrange 'adapted games' training
- Complete vetting/safeguarding training
- Ensure you have appropriate equipment
- Advertise in club area
- Ensure that all new members are registered under Games for All on the Foireann system
- Contact other clubs in your County for support if you need it (contact details below)
